NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Dogs must be registered with a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.
- Skilled and Proficient Categories will be combined for placements.
- Proceeds from this trial go toward helping to support the annual awards program and the Championships each year. In an effort to keep entry fees to a minimum, no ribbons will be awarded.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- In the event of a weather cancellation of classes, there will be no refunds. You will receive a credit for any other FUN-raiser trial. If you choose to go home early, then you do not receive a credit for those classes missed.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$35.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

Non-Jumping classes – Veteran Handler:

Disabled handlers or handlers aged 60 yrs. or older may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive additional standard course time. This division is for handlers only. The additional SCT is for qualifying purposes only for those who may need the additional time to negotiation the course due to physical limitations. Veteran Handlers in the non-jumping classes will be scored and placed with their standard division jump height. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all classes and all dogs in this division for the weekend.

Dogs must enter the Veterans Dog Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes.

This is a Containerized Trial

FOOD/TOYS IN POCKET: Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a Ziploc bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none can be left lying about loose. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over loose food or toys, diminish dogs dragging their handlers back to their crates (or wherever they left their food), and to lessen the amount of insects that are around loose food.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. Your dog's points can be found in the Members Section. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels: Dogs may not move up to a higher before they have completed a basic title at the previous level. A dog which has not competed in NADAC previously MUST enter at the Intro or Novice level.

Points earned in NADAC:

In NADAC competitions, all points earned at the same level (Intro, Novice, Open or Elite) combine for titles and awards, regardless of category (Skilled or Proficient) or division (Junior Handler, Veteran Handler, Vet Dog, Standard).

*Intro Level courses are shorter in length than Novice courses. Jump heights can be chosen by the handler without regard to the dog's height, with 16" being the maximum jump height allowed. There are no contact/tunnel discriminations and the only class with weaves is Intro Weavers with one set of six.

Daily Fees: \$10.00 per run

Junior Handlers = \$10.00 per dog/per day

DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES: We will accept day of show entries provided the trial has not filled. The day of show entry fee is \$12.00 a run. Please bring a completed/signed entry form with you to the trial.

AGREEMENT

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

Welcome to Ironwood Event and Boarding

Trials are held indoors on groomed dirt, in a <u>climate-controlled</u> environment. Crating is inside, so no Easy-Ups are necessary – just a mat, your X-pen or crate, and a chair. Dogs are restricted in some parts of the building (restrooms, showers, lunch room, etc.).

The facility has RV parking with hookups (electricity only or both electricity and water) for a nominal fee. RV parking needs to be arranged directly with Ironwood (see premium). Also included are the use of indoor restrooms, showers, and a fully functional lunch room with tables and chairs. Lunches can be pre-ordered from the facility (also see premium), and their staff will have them prepared and ready for purchase, or you can bring your own.

The facility is approximately 18 miles north of I-80 on Pyramid Way. It's an easy 20 minute drive out the Pyramid Highway. You'll know you've arrived when you drive <u>past</u> the BLM wild horse holding pens. DO NOT TURN ON IRONWOOD ROAD. Go past Ironwood Rd approximately ½ mile and turn right on Whiskey Springs Road. You really can't miss the facility. As you can see from the picture, it is quite large, and easily seen from the highway.

DIRECTIONS TO IRONWOOD EVENT CENTER 5600 Whiskey Springs Rd., Reno, NV

<u>From I-80 & Pyramid Way in Sparks:</u> Go north on Pyramid Way approx.. 18 miles to Whiskey Springs Rd., then turn right.

From Sacramento: Take I-80 East to the Pyramid Way off-ramp (at the Nugget). Turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Go north approx. 18 miles on Pyramid Way to Whiskey Springs Rd, then turn right.

From Carson City/Minden/Gardnerville via US 395: Take US395/I-580 North to I-80 East. Take I-80 East to the Pyramid Way off-ramp (at the Nugget). Turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Go north approx. 18 miles on Pyramid Way, to Whiskey Springs Rd, then turn right.

CAMPING

RV camping with hookups is available on-site. RV sites are available with electricity only (\$20/night), or both water and electricity (\$25/night). Dry camping is also available for \$15 per night, and tent camping is \$10 per night. You must reserve a spot for camping by calling the Events Center (775-475-0100). NADAC has nothing to do with the RV reservations or fees.
