Chances, (2) Regular, Touch n’ Go, (2) Hoopers, Jumpers

Sunday: Tall to Small – Elite, Open, Novice, Intro
Jumpers, Chances, (2) Regular, Weavers, Tunnelers

This run order is subject to change. A final run order will be included in your confirmations.

Parking:

You may unload your gear at either the front of the building or the rear of the building, but must park your car in the parking area in the front of the building after unloading.

FOOD:

Lunch orders can be sent to R2R with your entry. Do not include payment for your lunch. Payment will be collected by Ironwood when you pick up your lunch.

VOLUNTEERS:

We will have a worker's sign-up sheet at the trial. The Chief Ring Steward will call for volunteers for each class. We need everyone to help with a couple of classes each day. Workers will receive raffle tickets.

RAFFLE:

Raffle items will be displayed on Saturday and Sunday. The raffle drawing will be held on Sunday before the last class of the day. Volunteers will be "paid" with raffle tickets for each class they work. We will also be selling raffle tickets this year!

AWARDS:

Qualifying rosettes will be awarded in all jump heights and placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th places. No placement ribbons will be awarded in the Chances Class as it is a pass/fail class.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & WARM-UPS:

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of each class. Walk-through periods will be held prior to each class following the judge's briefing. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

CLASS ADDITIONS AND MOVE-UPS:

If your dog is entered in the trial, you may add additional classes for a fee of \$13 per class. Move-ups are allowed if done immediately following the last class of the day on Friday and Saturday.

DISCLAIMER

Ready 2 Run Agility Club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

READY 2 RUN POLICIES

- **Ready 2 Run Agility Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.** The organizing committee may also refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through NADAC rules and regulations or guidelines established by NADAC.
- Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC cannot enter the trial.
- Only handlers who are officially entered in the trial and have submitted an application with the handler's signature accepting "Agreement" and Ready 2 Run Policies, will be allowed to run dogs in the trial.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Please clean up after yourself and your dog.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank-returned checks.
- There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- Refunds will be issued for bitches in season if submitted in writing BEFORE the trial date, with a statement from your veterinarian.
- No setups within 10 feet of any ring, please.

Categories

- Each class contains two categories, Proficient and Skilled. A dog may only be entered in ONE category per weekend. In the Skilled Category, dogs **must** jump 4” lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog may jump less than 4”).
- **As of January-2014:** Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes
- In the Regular Agility Class, dogs may incur 5 or fewer faults, and earn a 5 point qualifying round. A qualifying round must be clean and will earn 10 points. *(Please refer to www.nadacforum.com for the latest information and explanation of the Skilled and Proficient categories).*
- Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler: Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.
- The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.
- When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4” lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. Your points are updated and can be found on the www.NADACforum.com website within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog’s qualifying points, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here, "NADAC" means North American Dog Agility Council, LLC, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property, and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas, and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people, exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC, Ready 2 Run Agility Club (including their officers, directors, members, and event organizing committees), and Carson City, including its officers, agents and employees, and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury damage, claims, demands, and liabilities involving the entered dog, the jury damage, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

DIRECTIONS TO IRONWOOD
5600 Whiskey Springs Road Sparks, NV

The facility is approximately 18 miles north of I-80 on Pyramid Way. It's an easy 20 minute drive out the Pyramid Highway. You'll know you have arrived when you drive past the BLM wild horse holding pens. **DO NOT TURN ON IRONWOOD ROAD.** Go past Ironwood Road approximately ½ mile and turn right onto Whiskey Springs Road. You really can't miss the facility, it is easily seen from the highway.

From I-80 & Pyramid Way in Sparks: Go north on Pyramid Way 18 miles to Whiskey Springs Road, then turn right.

From Sacramento: Take I-80 East to the Pyramid Way off-ramp (at the Nugget). Turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Go north on Pyramid Way 18 miles to Whiskey Springs Road, then turn right.

From Carson City/Minden/Gardnerville via US 395: Take US 395/I-580 North to I-80 East. Take I-80 East to the Pyramid Way off-ramp (at the Nugget). Turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Go north on Pyramid Way 18 miles to Whiskey Springs Road, then turn right.

IRONWOOD RULES
Please Review Carefully

We are very fortunate to use this wonderful facility for our agility trials. In order to be able to keep on using it, we have agreed that our exhibitors will cooperate with the following rules:

- Dogs are to be leashed at all times unless in the ring, or in a designated off-leash area.
- Exhibitors are NOT to use the dirt planters to potty their dogs (Please stay out of the dirt planters altogether). Dogs are to be walked on-leash to the bare dirt, sagebrush areas to potty. If at all possible, do not allow your dogs to potty on any grass.
- All exhibitors must leave the facility Sunday after the trial. No overnight camping Sunday evening.
- If BBQ's are used, they must be gas BBQ's—no charcoal please.
- Thanks for your cooperation. We really need your help in maintaining our use of this facility.
